

## 2010-2011 School Supplies

If you would like to provide school supplies for your child, your child's classroom or to the school in general, the following supplies **are always needed throughout the school year:**

Reams of white copy paper  
Boxes of facial tissues  
Low-odor dry erase black markers  
Paper towels

The following ***“Recommended School Supply List”*** was sent home at the end of the 2009-2010 school year:

### **Kindergarten**

These supplies apply to grade level. *Please note that some of the specific supplies listed may not be used by every teacher of this grade level.*

5 reams of copy paper  
pencil grips  
erasers  
2 sets dry erase markers  
2 colored pencils  
3 old magazines (will not be returned-will use for pictures)  
3 boxes of Kleenex  
glue sticks  
box of 24 crayons  
baby wipes – alcohol free  
SMALL backpack  
hard plastic lunch paid (because of squirrels)  
water color paints  
3 2-pocket folders  
spiral notebook-wide ruled  
file folders  
plastic pencil box  
healthy snacks for the classroom: raisins, pretzels, graham crackers  
roll of paper towels  
box of sandwich size plastic baggies  
box of gallon size plastic baggies

## **First Grade**

These supplies apply to grade level. *Please note that some of the specific supplies listed may not be used by every teacher of this grade level.*

5 reams of copy paper  
pencil box that closes  
18 pack twistable colored pencils  
4 glue sticks  
1 box of Kleenex  
1 box unscented, alcohol-free baby wipes  
2 boxes of 16 count crayons  
6 yellow #2 pencils – no fancy pencils  
3 dry erase (low-odor) markers  
\*please do not send scissors, rulers or markers for coloring

## **2<sup>nd</sup> Grade**

5 reams of copy paper  
2 packages dry erase (low-odor) markers  
Composition book  
box of 24 crayons  
primary pencils (thick large grip type) box of 10 or 12  
box of Kleenex  
band-aids  
baby wipes – alcohol free  
paper towels

## **3<sup>rd</sup> Grade**

USB drive (1 Gigabyte)

1 package low-odor dry erase markers  
box of 24 crayons  
erasers  
pencil-top erasers  
pack of glue sticks  
6 2-pocket folders  
2 spiral notebooks – wide ruled  
1 inch 3-ring binder  
1 package lined paper – wide ruled  
pair of scissors  
graphing paper  
1 Composition book (black/white cover)  
2 white poster boards

5 plastic paper sheet protectors  
USB drive
